

## **SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Please read these in full before completing & returning your permission slip by 1st October 2023.

- 1. All costumes, show fees and tickets are non-refundable.
- 2. Full commitment to lessons, and performances is required from every student wishing to participate. The commitment to rehearsals is the same for each participant regardless of how many dances they are in.
  - Weekly classes will continue to include all of our students. We want to encourage them to gain performance skills even if they cannot attend the show, as such skills will be needed in future performance events and exams. Please keep a look-out for upcoming events!!
- 3. There is a show fee of £50.00 which is due by 10th October 2024. This is non refundable and helps to cover the following costs:
  - chaperone licences
  - extra studio hire time
  - extra teacher costs
  - props
  - show photos
  - a complimentary souvenir t-shirt which will be worn in the finale

All costume fees must be paid by the 1st November 2024 and both show fee and costume fees are non refundable.

- 4. Permission slips must be returned to me by 8th October. We need to have final confirmation of numbers on that date due to the large amount of organisation involved in putting together a show of this size. Forms handed in after this date will be accepted at our discretion and responses verbally, by text or email will also not be accepted.
- 5. Due to the performance being held in a professional theatre, taking photographs and filming of the show by the audience is **strictly prohibited**.
- 6. Parents/helpers are not permitted at the side of the stage; should you wish to watch the show you must purchase a ticket.
- 6. All students participating will be under the care of volunteer parent chaperones. By allowing your child to participate, you give us permission to act in loco parentis.
- 7. In any unfortunate incident requiring first aid, we will perform any necessary first aid without gaining parental consent should we see it fit to do so.

- 8. Verbal or physical abuse to our staff or chaperones is not tolerated. Anyone deemed to be acting inappropriately by the Principal will be asked to leave immediately. They will be unable to participate in future school events.
- 9. Any damage or losses to rented costumes, props, dressing rooms caused by students or chaperones will be charged to the parents.
- 10. All students will be named in the show programme and will be filmed and photographed on the day. Without photo permission from their parents, students will not be able to take part in the show. Photos will be used for advertising purposes including for use on social media open pages.
